

Uniform Policy

September 2024

Our school uniform is very important to us here at Thrybergh Fullerton. It enables us to support children in having a strong sense of identity and belonging within our school. We encourage children to wear uniform every day.

Our school uniform consists of:

- black or grey trousers (shorts are acceptable too in the summer time)
- black or grey skirts, or dresses (pinafores, gingham dresses, skort sets)
- White or red polo shirts, or white shirts (with or without logo)
- Red or grey jumpers or cardigans (with or without logo)
- Fleeces can be worn in the school colour (red) if parents wish
- Black trainers or shoes with minimal branding on show.

PE kit

Indoor PE:

Our PE kit is black shorts, skort or leggings and a white or red round neck t-shirt.

Outdoor PE:

Black joggers and white or red polo round neck t-shirt with a school jumper. A plain red, black or grey fleece/hoody is allowed.

Trainers or pumps should be provided for both indoor and outdoor PE lessons.

All clothing must have names on them.

Please note that any items of clothing, whether school uniform or PE kit, should display no or very little and discrete branding.

Jewellery and Accessories

- **Earrings:** Only small, plain stud earrings are allowed. For safety reasons, no other types of earrings or piercings are permitted. Further to this, earrings must not be worn in PE. Where earrings cannot be removed, children will need to cover earrings using athlete's tape or a plaster. Children should bring plasters and will be expected to cover their own earrings.
- **Watches:** Simple watches are allowed, but smartwatches or any watches that connects to the internet are not permitted.
- Hair: Long hair should be tied back neatly
- Headwear: Hats, caps, or other head coverings are not allowed inside the school building, except for religious or medical reasons.

Please note that any other jewellery (rings, bracelets, necklaces etc) is not permitted and children will be asked to remove.

Makeup and Nail Varnish

- Makeup: Makeup of any kind, including foundation, mascara, or eye shadow, is not permitted.
- Nail Varnish: Acrylic nails, or false nails are not allowed in school.

Non-Compliance

Students who do not adhere to the uniform policy will be politely reminded and may be asked to adjust their appearance accordingly. In the case of persistent non-compliance, parents or guardians will be contacted to discuss the matter.

We appreciate the support of parents and carers in maintaining our uniform standards, which help create a focused and respectful learning environment for all.

Where uniform can be purchased

We have a few recommendations for purchasing the school uniform, either with or without the school logo. Pinders, Johnny D's or Ella Bella's in the town centre supply our uniform with logos. Many supermarkets and shops such as Asda, Tesco, Marks and Spencer, Next and Sainsburys also have school uniform to purchase too. We do not expect parents and carers to buy uniform with the school logo.

We have supplies of spare uniform in school which we are happy to supply for families who need it. Please contact the school office if you would like to access uniform from school. When children are not wearing the correct uniform for school, they will be provided with freshly laundered school items which they are able to wear for the day. This also applies to PE kit. We ask that children come to school wearing PE kit on PE days.
